Karmen MacKendrick is Professor of Philosophy at Le Moyne College. Her multidisciplinary research interests center on questions of language, corporeality, and temporality, primarily in relation to theology and religious studies. They also touch upon the arts (particularly dance), cultural studies (particularly the arts of the body), and literature. She is co-author, with Virginia Burrus and Mark Jordan, of the forthcoming *Seducing Augustine* (Fordham University Press). Her monographs include *Counterpleasures* (SUNY Press), *Immemorial Silence* (SUNY Press), *Word Made Skin: Figuring Language at the Surface of Flesh* (Fordham University Press), and *Fragmentation and Memory: Meditations on Christian Doctrine* (Fordham University Press). With Ellen Feder and Sybol Cook she has co-edited an anthology titled *A Passion for Wisdom: Readings in Western Philosophy on Love and Desire* (Pearson).
